- Please do not include any candy or chocolate.
- Do not use materials that can easily break away or become damaged. Valentines will be delivered to the VA hospital, and it is important that the veteran receives it in the same beautiful condition as when it was made.

Tips for creating valentines:

- Tell the veteran about yourself: your first name, age, and school you attend. <u>Please do not include your last name, phone number(s), email address or mailing address.</u>
- Tell the veteran why it is important, this year and every year, to celebrate those who serve us in the military.
- O Include a message.
- Write a poem.

After your valentines are completed:

- Call 469-304-0382 to schedule a time for you to drop off valentines at my Plano Office.
- If you have more than 150 valentines and are unable to drop off valentines, please call my Plano office to coordinate a pick-up time at your school.
